Condition $y(-1) = 2$. [10]

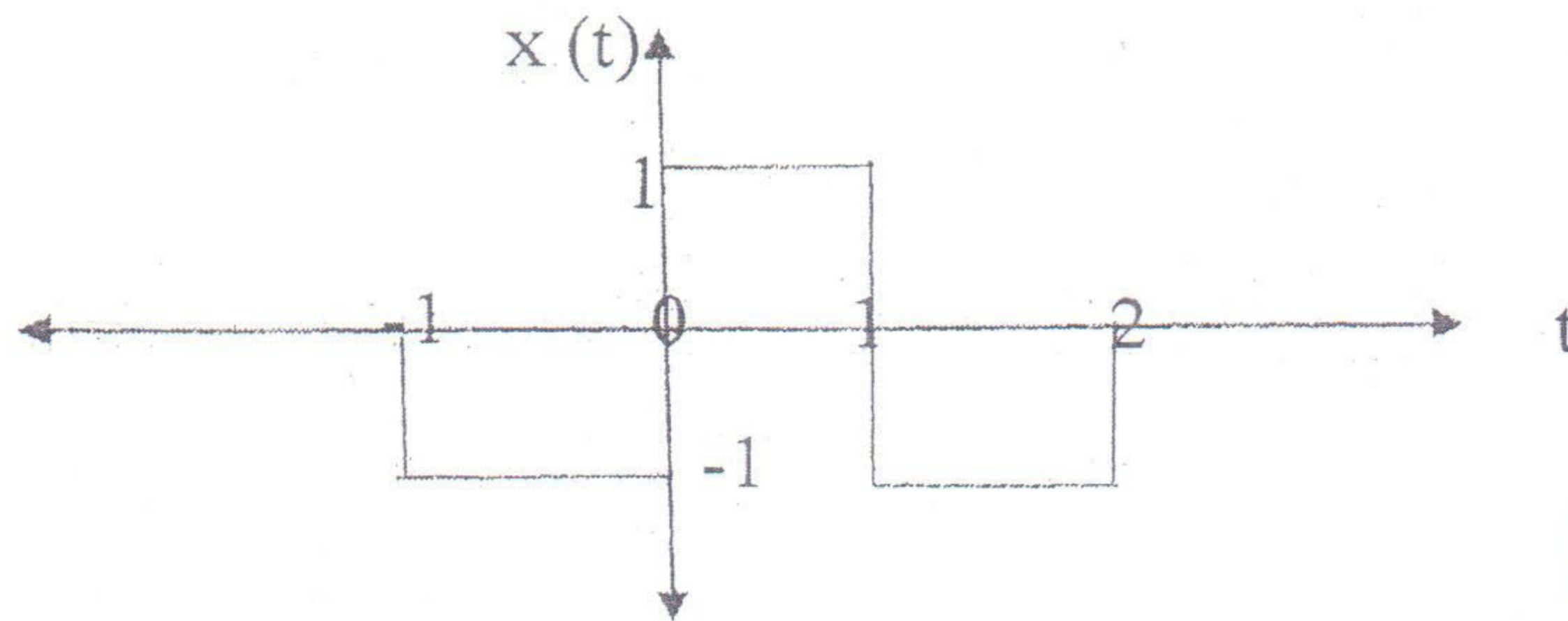
